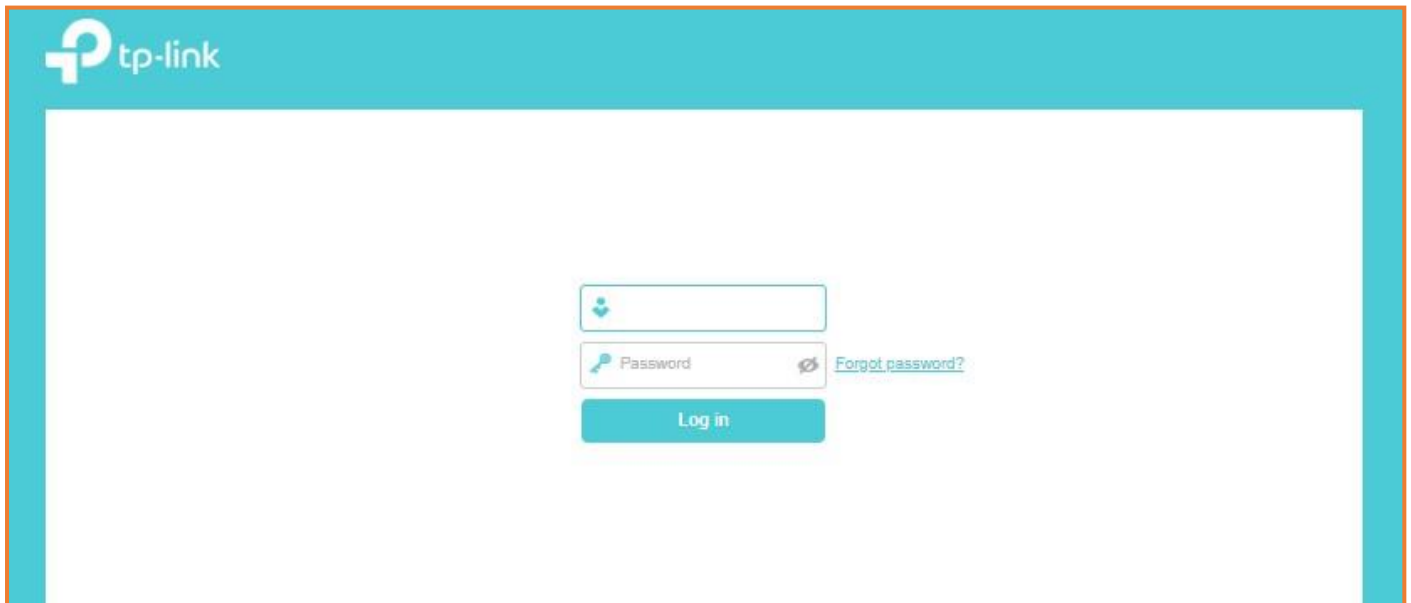

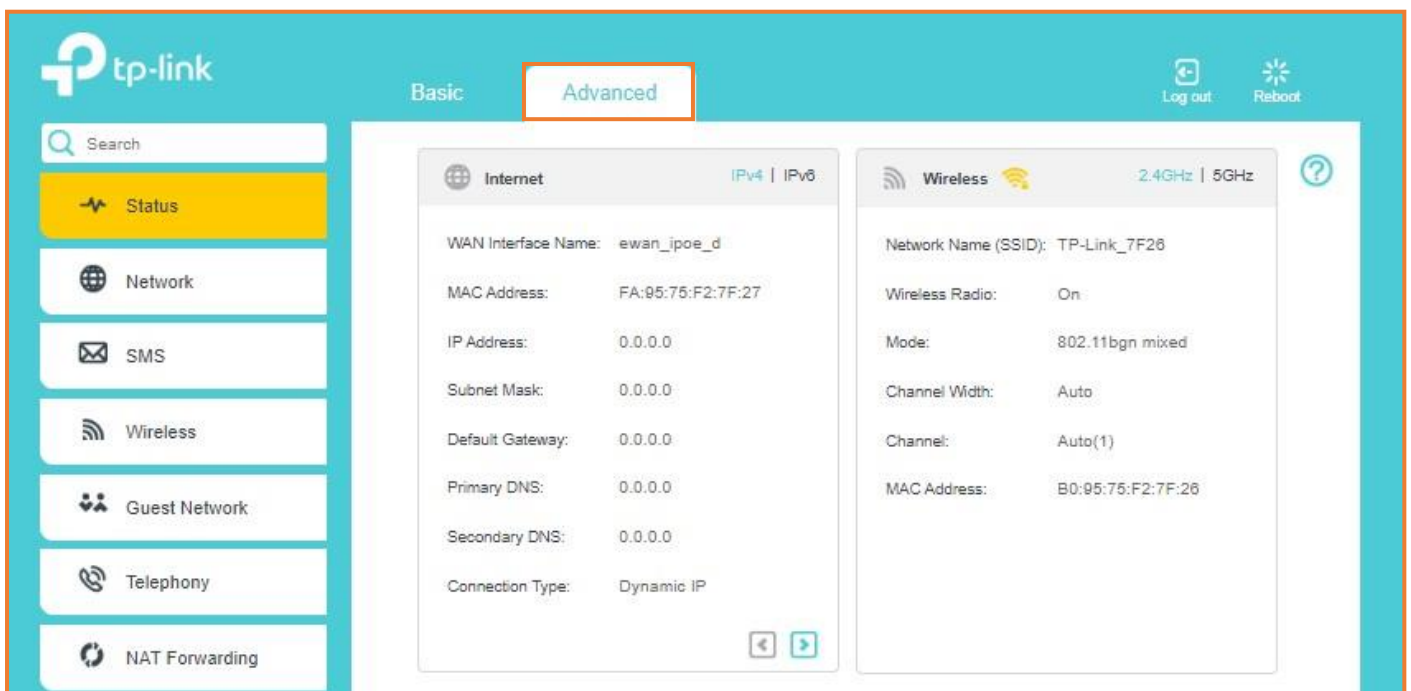
1. Connect your computer to the router via a wired or wireless connection.

Enter the default **Username** and **Password (admin and admin)**



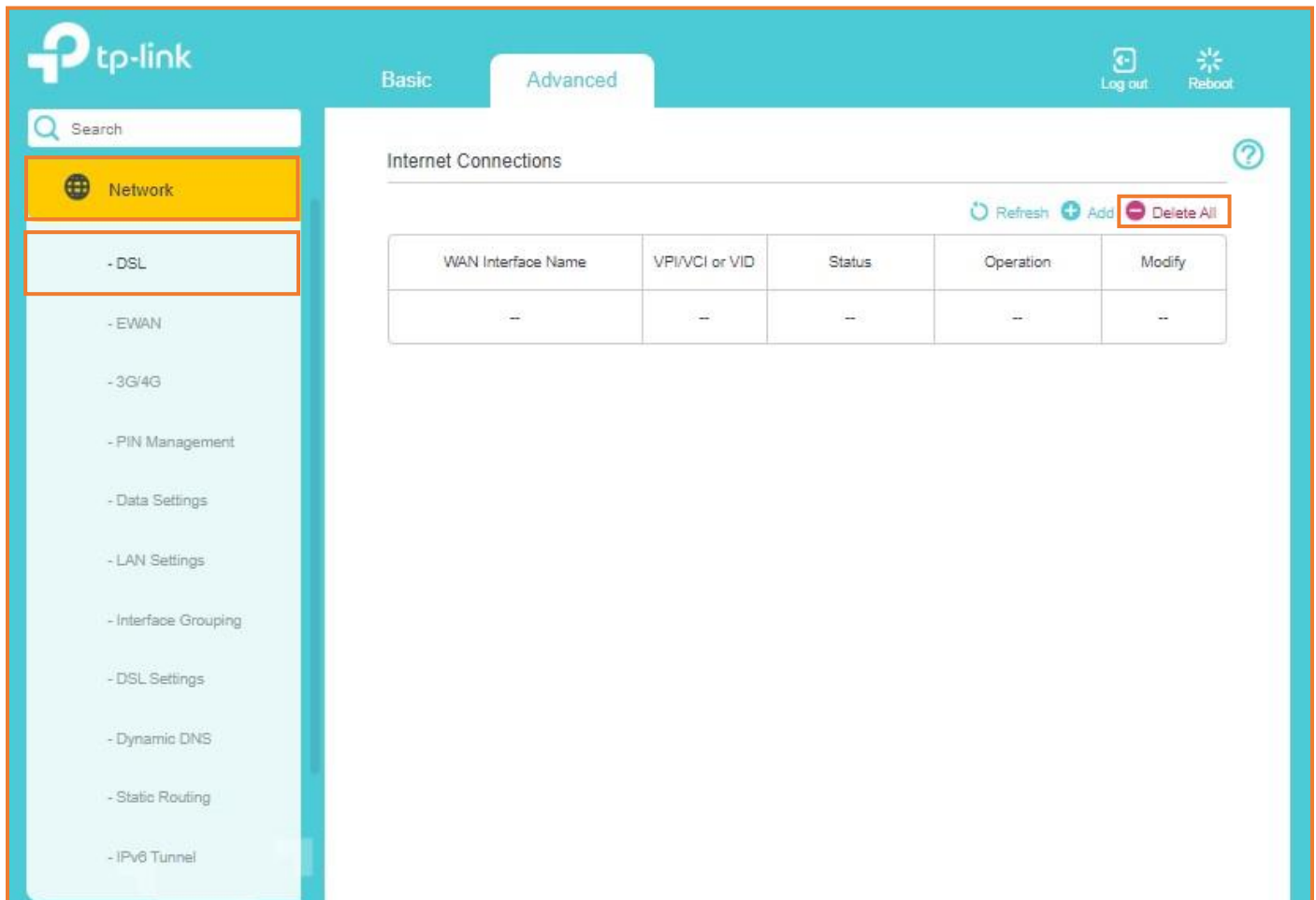
Step 2.

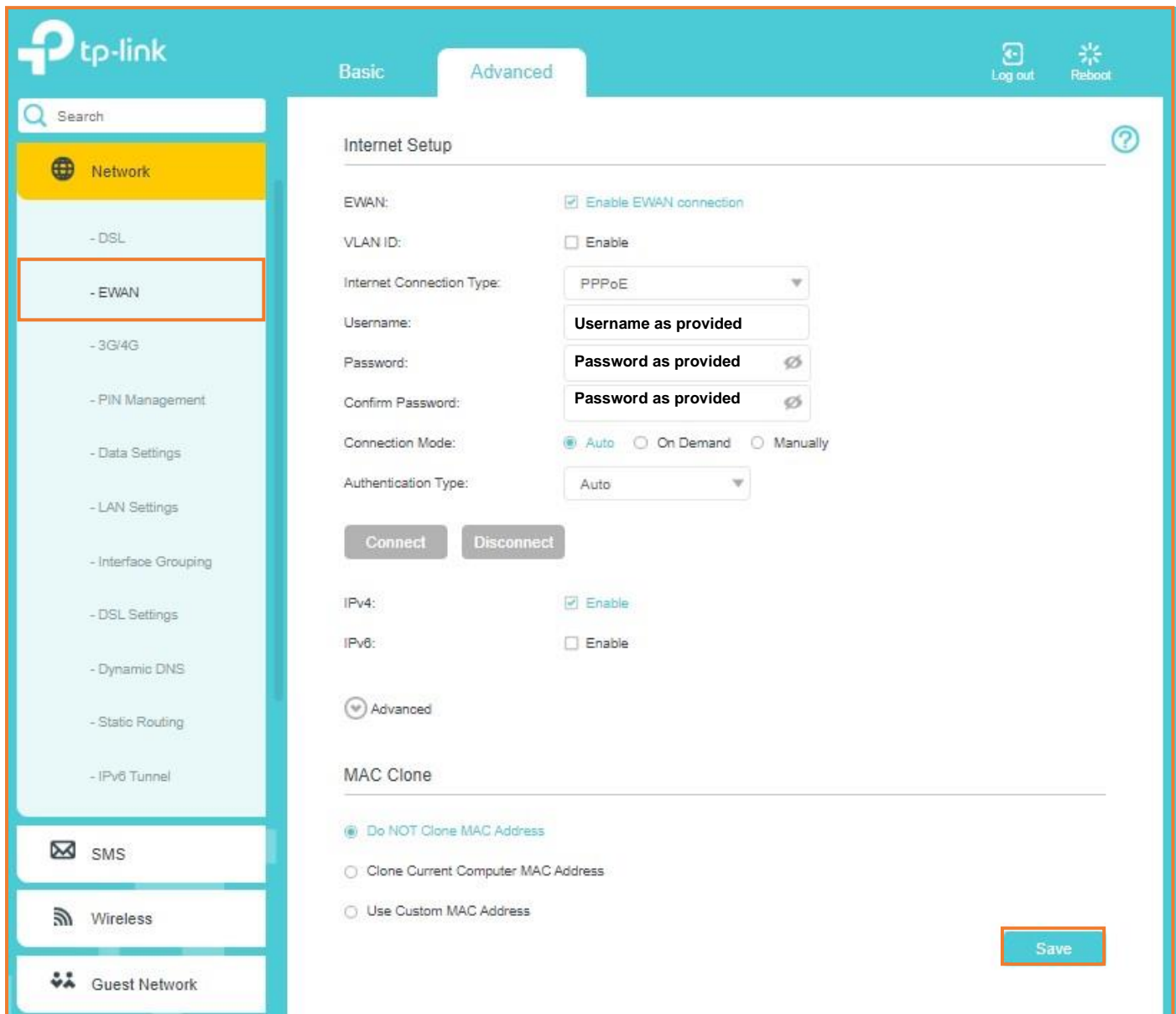
